GREEN SCHOOLS QUEST

The Green Schools Quest is a project-based challenge to K-12 schools in Missouri and southern Illinois to devise and implement the most creative, effective and no- or low-cost sustainability practices with the help of a Green Mentor.

Each school forms a team of student participants which is organized by one adult representative from the school (the 'School Lead' - often a teacher). Teams may be a single classroom, a student club, a grade level, or an entire school. A Green Mentor is assigned to each school and works together with the School Lead to support the students by providing guidance, resources and encouragement as needed. Each team engages in their chosen sustainability project(s) between October 2022 and March 2023, and submits their outcomes for a chance to win cash prizes.
