



Board Nomination Guidelines

Missouri Gateway Green Building Council's Board of Directors is comprised of four officers – Chair, Chair Elect, Secretary, and Treasurer – plus the Past Chair, four to five At-Large members, two to four Advisors, an Executive Director, and one representative each from the Ozarks and Mid-Missouri Branches. - Nominations are open for At-Large Director seats. Directors will serve **three-year terms** beginning in 2024.
- The Board will identify from newly selected members and the existing members the specific 2024 officer assignments through Dynamic Elections. *
- All terms begin in 2024.
- Board members must be [members](#) in good standing with Missouri Gateway Green Building Council.
- At-Large Board members must currently serve or have previously served on a Missouri Gateway Green Building Council committee, task force, as a volunteer, etc.
- All Board members are expected to participate in monthly Board meetings as well as attend one or two planning retreats during the year. Board meetings and retreats are currently held in the St. Louis area with a hybrid option via Zoom.
- All board members are expected to make a personal donation to the organization beyond their membership fees in an amount that is meaningful to the individual board member and to play a role in overall fundraising for the organization.

Nomination Timeline

- Nominations Open – Monday, July 10, 2023
- Nominations Due – Friday, August 18, 2023 by 5:00 pm
- Governance Committee Proposes Slate to Board for review–September 14, 2023
- Board Approves Slate at or before December 2023 meeting
- Announcement to General Membership in once Slate approved
- New Board Member Orientation – TBA in late November / early December 2023
- State of the Council Program – January 2023 (exact date TBA)
- Board meetings currently scheduled for the 2nd Thursday of every month from 4:00 – 5:30 pm at the Council office (with hybrid option via Zoom).

* In 2015, we are shifted our nomination and election process. We continue to accept nominations from the membership, which the Governance Committee reviews for eligibility and leadership needs. In place of elections, the Governance Committee determines a slate to present to the board for approval.
